- AND**
- **Develop media writing and digital media production skills** guided by an expert

Requirements

- Appx 20-25 hours in 1:1, individual production work, and small group settings (20% face to face with storyteller: 20% with story mentor (M. Weaver); 60% digital editing of narrative , graphics, titles, audio, images, sound, music, magic). Guides and 1:1 teaching provided.
 - Comfort with simple digital editing tools and online resources (e.g. imovie)
 - Openness to learn the skill of "subtractive writing" as part of the editing/story mounting process. A writing skill in high demand in today's world.
 - Willingness to learn simple, specific interviewing and conversational skills as part of strengthening "emotional intelligence" competencies.
