The Fallbrook Senior Center is offering a new Intergenerational Program Opportunity.

Selected students are being offered an opportunity to both:

- **Partner with an adult storyteller** to translate their oral story into impactful, visual form (to be mounted in the Fallbrook Storytelling Project Community Archive)

AND

- Develop media writing and digital media production skills guided by an expert

Requirements

-Appx 20-25 hours in 1:1, individual production work, and small group settings (20% face to face with storyteller: 20% with story mentor (M Weaver); 60% digital editing of narrative, graphics, titles, audio, images, sound, music, magic)

- -Comfort with simple digital editing tools and online resources (e.g. imovie)
- -Openness to learn the skill of "subtractive writing" as part of the editing/story mounting process. A writing skill in high demand in today's world.
- -Willingness to learn simple, specific interviewing and conversational skills as part of strengthening "emotional intelligence" competencies
